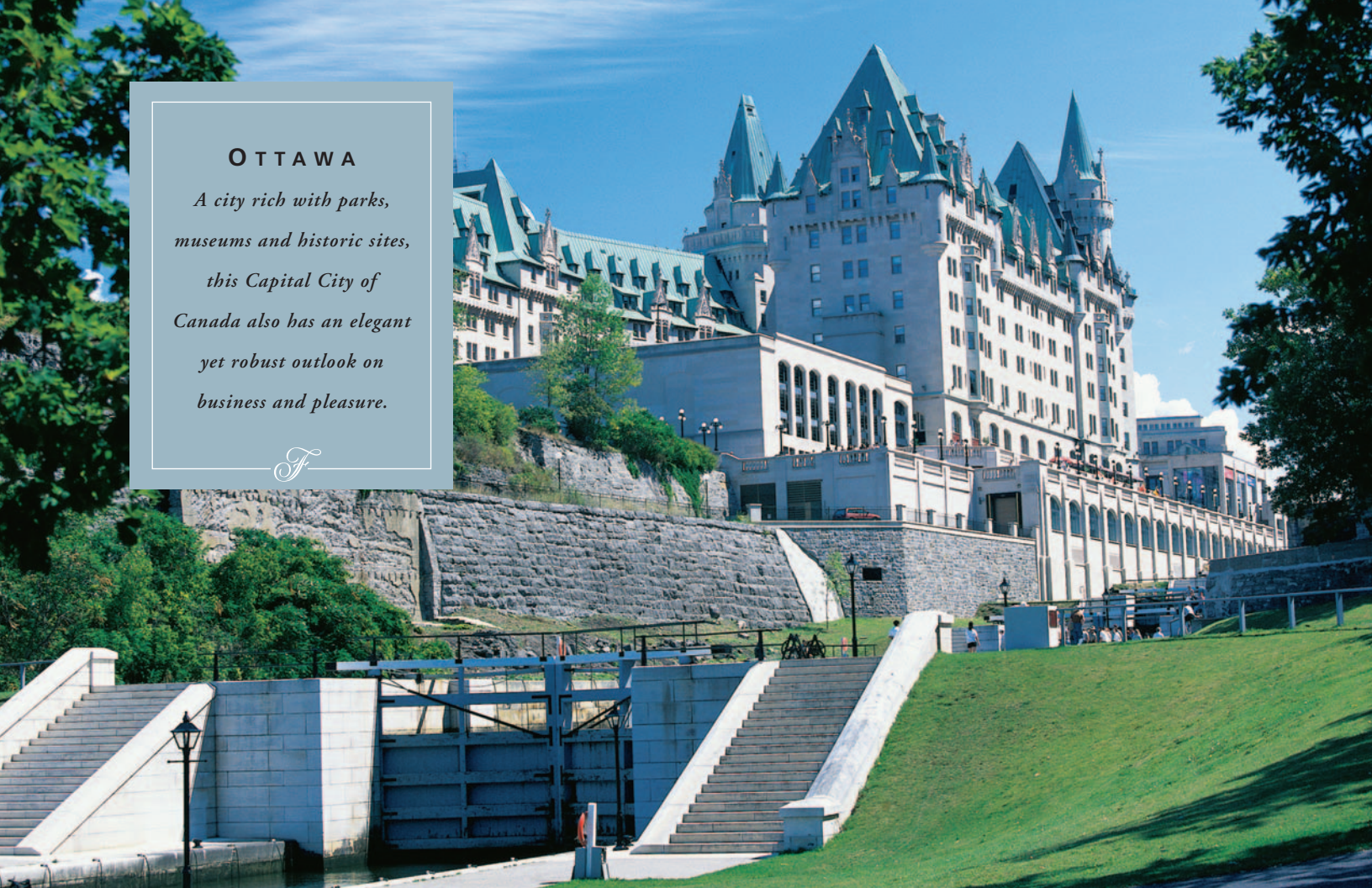

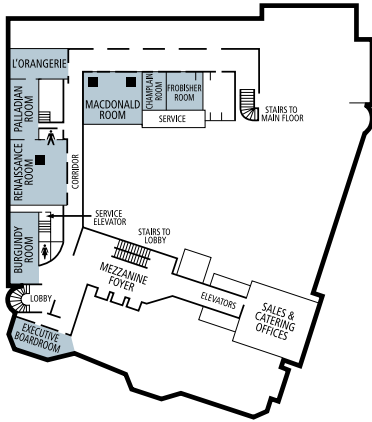
FAIRMONT CHÂTEAU LAURIER

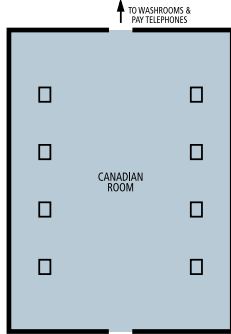

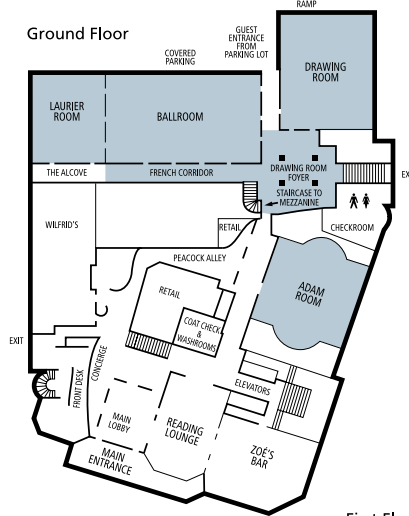
Mezzanine



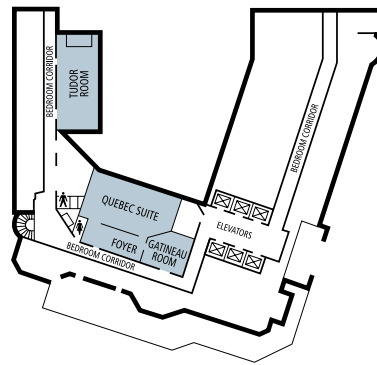
Lower Level
