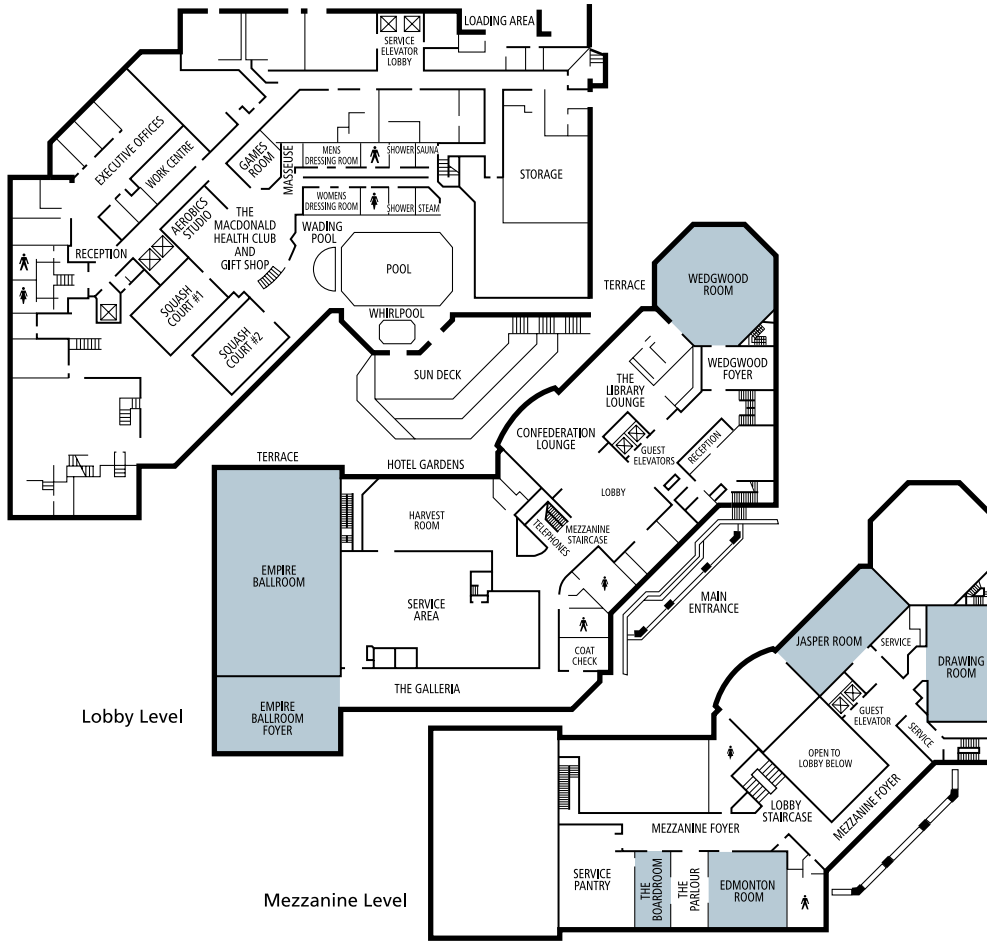


THE FAIRMONT HOTEL MACDONALD
