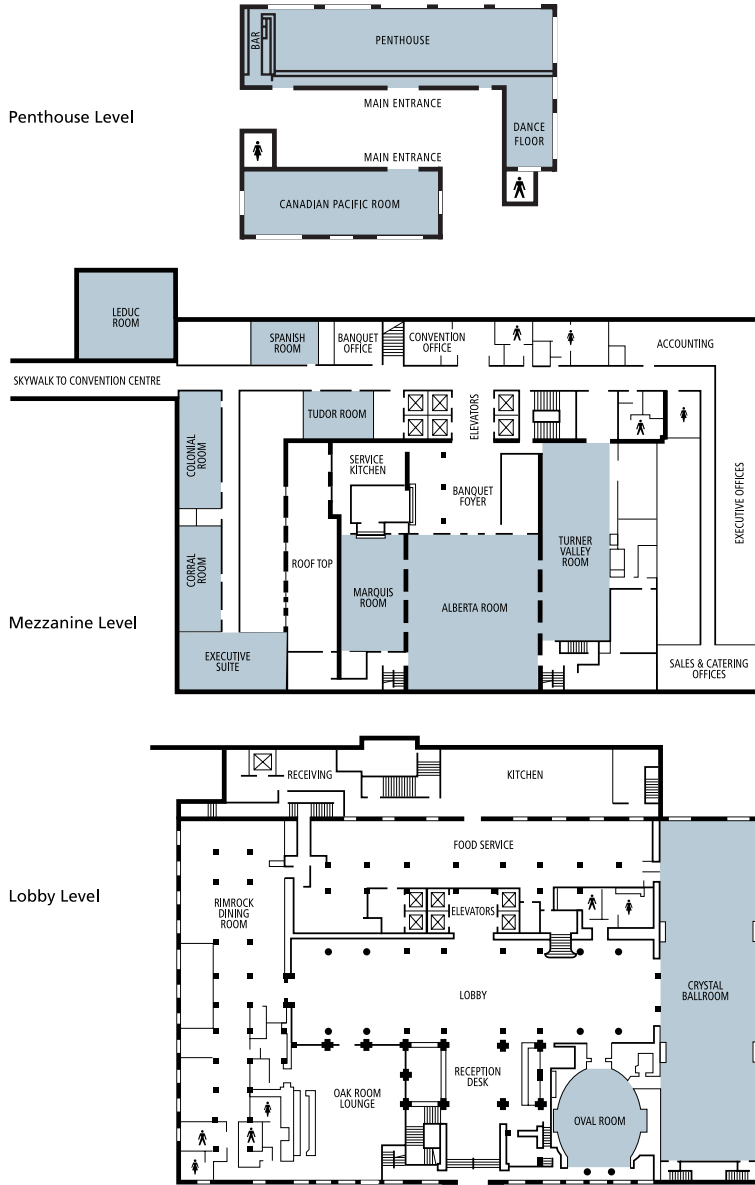


THE FAIRMONT PALLISER
