Heard Museum & The Desert Botanical Garden

The Desert Botanical Garden is the only botanical garden dedicated entirely to the study of desert plant life, displaying more than 15,000 desert plants in colorful and intriguing displays. Located in the heart of beautiful Papago Park, the garden's meandering paths and vibrant exhibits draw more than 100,000 visitors each year. Continue on to the internationally acclaimed Heard Museum, one of the best places to experience and learn about the fascinating cultures and art of Native Americans of the Southwest. Founded in 1929 the museum is home to an extensive collection of artifacts, fine art, unique exhibits and innovative programming. Duration: 4 – 5 hours

AERIAL EXCURSIONS

Sonoran Desert Balloon Flights

There's no better way to experience the tranquility of the Sonoran Desert. Board a gondola and climb to a thousand feet above the desert floor for a breathtaking flight in a hot air balloon. Riders feel the exhilaration of smooth air travel as they soar above desert plateaus and outcroppings. Keep your eyes open for some of the desert's natural inhabitants, including coyotes, hawks, javalina and deer. Your FAA certified pilot is an expert on the legends and lore of the area, and will supply a colorful narrative as the ride unfolds. Once you touch down, the occasion will be marked with a traditional toast and flight certificate ceremony. Duration: 3.5 hours

PADDLE UP

Desert River Float

See the desert's natural beauty in a way that few take advantage of. For a spectacular outdoor experience, climb aboard these oversized rafts for a serene, scenic float down one of Arizona's pristine waterways. While you may be asked to ply your paddle from time to time, the slow and steady current performs most of the work on these picturesque river journeys. Witness dazzling Sonoran Desert scenery, and you may even encounter some of the state's more famous wildlife. Wild horses, herons, and any number of creatures can be spotted on the banks and in the skies. For a longer or more complete experience, we can enhance your excursion with a variety of water or land based games and activities, lunch, or dinner. Duration: 4 hours

RED ROCK RENDEZVOUS

Sedona & Oak Creek Canyon Tour

Experience the stunning, high country beauty of Northern Arizona to discover the softer side of our desert state. Climb 3,000 feet from the desert floor to cooler climates, paying a visit to Montezuma Castle, a five story, twenty room cliff dwelling carved into the side of the mountain by the Sinagua Indians more than 800 years ago. As you near Sedona, towering, vibrant red rock formations form one of the most captivating horizons you've ever witnessed. The town of Sedona is nestled between these monumental formations, and is the state's second most visited attraction. Awesome natural beauty is paired with small town charm, as visitors stroll walkways in search of art, artifacts and keepsakes of their visit to this inspired place. Shop and browse amidst the shade trees of the Spanish arts and crafts village called Tlaquepaque. Just to the north of Sedona, take in the beauty of Oak Creek Canyon, where spirited waters flow at the foot of dense evergreen forests. Duration: 7 – 9 hours

MILITARY MUSCLE

Desert Hummer Tours

There isn't another vehicle like it anywhere in the world. Climb aboard the military's preferred form of transport in a Hummer H1. It's the ideal way to experience the daunting landscape of the desert, where inclines, washes and brush render most vehicles useless. Sit high above the desert floor and explore the vast, scenic horizons of the Sonoran Desert. Wildlife sightings are frequent, and your guide will be quick to identify the creatures that roam the landscape. A super-wide wheelbase and sturdy frame will transport you to places few have seen. And just when you think your driver has descended into the impossible, your Hummer will rise to the occasion and deliver you back to the path. Off-road adventure at its best. Duration: 4 hours

ARCHITECTURAL DIGEST

Frank Lloyd Wright Taliesin West

In 1937, famed architect Frank Lloyd Wright designed and built a remarkable set of structures in the foothills of the McDowell Mountains, known as Taliesin West. Set amid 600 acres of Sonoran beauty in North Scottsdale, Taliesin West was more than Wright's personal winter residence and studio. It was also the home of the Taliesin Fellowship, a group of 23 young architectural "disciples" who built the complex under Wright's direction. Long regarded by architectural critics as a masterpiece, the U.S. government declared Taliesin West a National Historic Landmark in 1987. During this ninety minute walking tour, your guide will explain the history and significance of the architecture. You'll visit the Seminar Theatre, Music Pavilion, Cabaret Cinema, Frank Lloyd Wright's private office and the dramatic Taliesin West living room. Duration: 3 hours

LET'S RIDE

Sonoran Desert Horseback Riding

Not too long ago, horseback was the preferred form of transport in the Valley. Take a step back in time and explore the Sonoran Desert from the saddle. Guides lead you into the heart of the desert, where mountain ranges and desert plateaus will make you forget you're so close to the city. Journey through groves of mesquite, across ever changing terrain and into a state of mind that's pure enjoyment. Keep your eyes on the horizon, and you may be rewarded with a glimpse of Arizona wildlife, from hawks, eagles and other birds of prey to the creatures that roam the desert floor. Take a surreal journey through one of the scenic jewels of the desert southwest. Duration: 3.5 hours

ACTION AND TRACTION

Four-Wheel Drive Desert Excursion

While the Sonoran Desert offers some of the most scenic, rugged terrain in the western US, there are few ways to access it. Enter the domain of the four-wheel drive vehicle for an off-road adventure you'll never forget. Experience the full range of emotions, from awestruck wonder at the desert's foreboding beauty to white-knuckle excitement as your seasoned driver executes the seemingly impossible. Drivers are well-versed in the legends and lore of the desert, and will pass on their stories as you make your way through the beautiful surroundings. This ride to remember includes a mini walk-about, where you can step out and experience the desert first-hand. Depending on the season, you may even get to sample some of the tastes of the desert, like prickly pear fruit and other Sonoran treats. Duration: 4 hours

GRAVITY ACTIVATED

Glider Flights

Head west to the open desert for a flight of fancy unlike any other. Climb aboard an aerodynamic glider and discover an activity that leaves everyone with wide smiles. A tow plane pulls your glider along the runway and up into the sky via harness, and at the ideal moment, releases you and your pilot into the skies. The glider experience is super-smooth, quiet, and most of all, exhilarating. Riding pockets of air, your pilot can engage in a simple, smooth descent, or can break into any number of acrobatic sweeps, turns and maneuvers. And if you're up to the challenge, they'll even let you take the stick and assume command of the experience. Upon touchdown, an official logbook and certificate mark your historic journey into the vibrant blue desert skies. Duration: varied depending on group size.
